



# **DE-ESCALATION TECHNIQUES**





Stay calm, try to put personal feelings aside.



Avoid interrupting, be concerned, and try to understand the speaker.

# **DE-ESCALATION TECHNIQUES** (cont.)



Repeat what you understand to be the issue to show you have heard them. Ask more questions to clarify.



Try to brainstorm positions actions that might address their concerns. If that is not possible emphasize the reasons for any restrictions.


