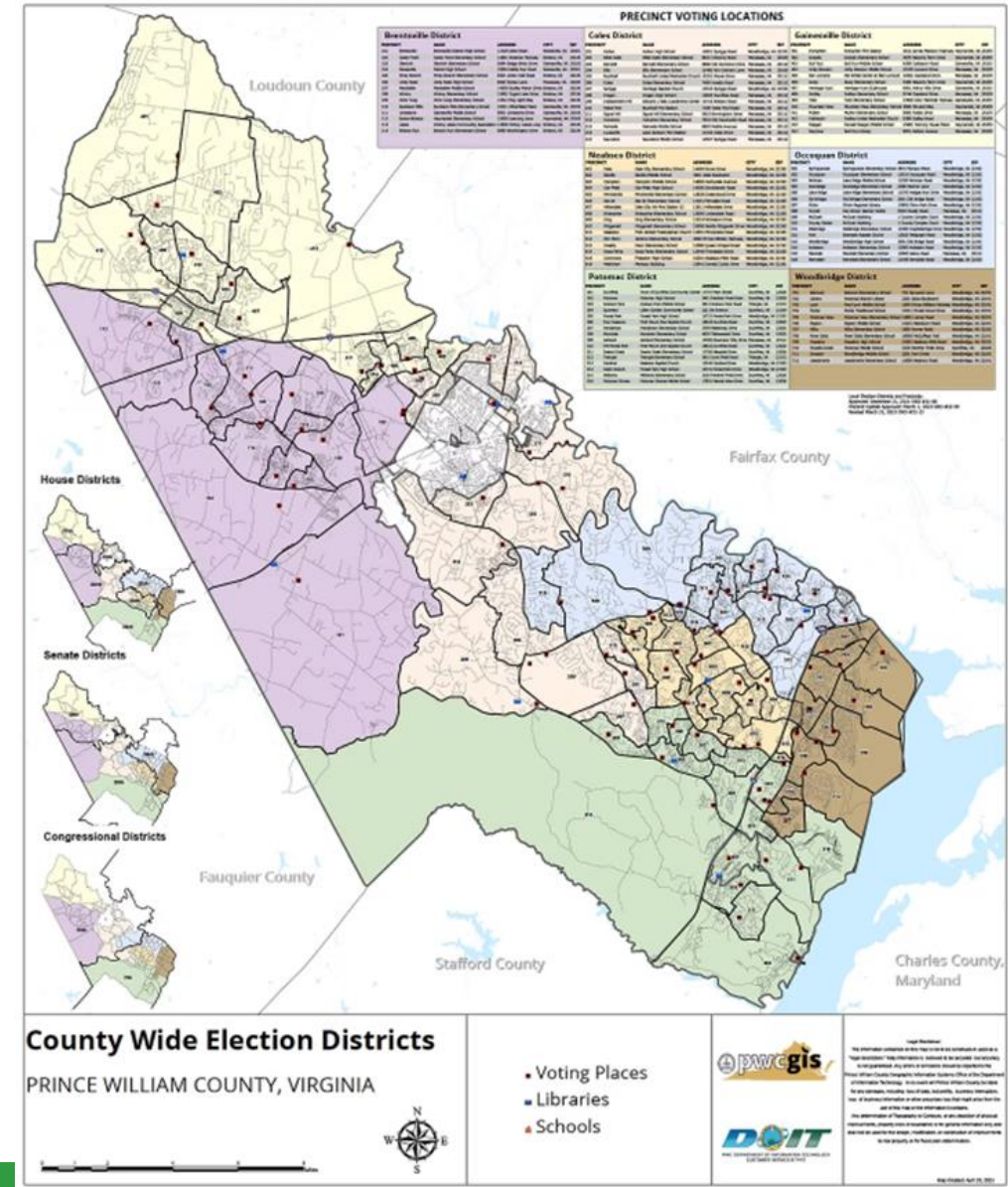

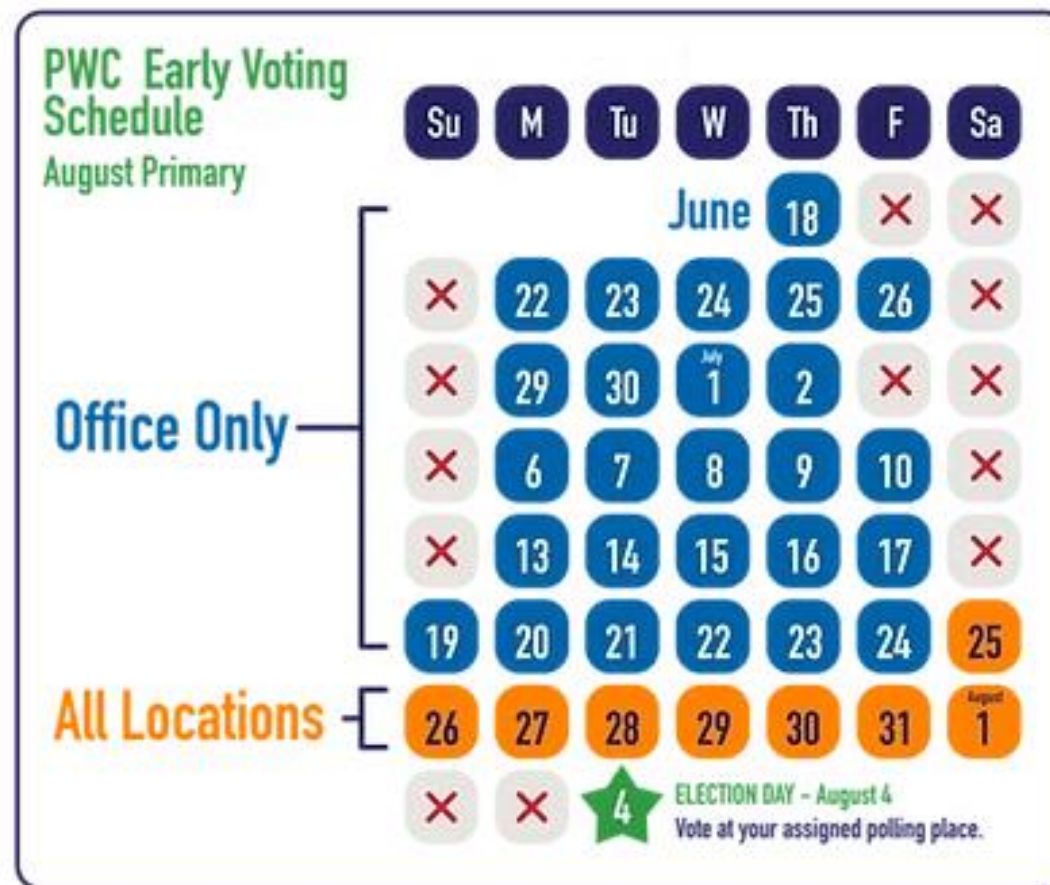

What's New

- **Starting July 1** Affirmation of Eligibility form will change
 - Voter challenges can no longer happen in polling places





Reminders

- 17yr olds turning 18 by General Election (11/3) can vote
- Don't accept IDs issued by other states
 - Example – FL License w/ VA address
- Virginia is an open primary state
 - Voters do not register by party
- Clean the scanner lens daily
- Envelopes fit up to 400 ballots





Reminders

Daily Opening Tasks

- Administer required oaths
- Log in to pollbooks and produce printer reports
- Verify ballot box(es) are empty and seal
- Open ballot scanner(s) and touchwriter
- Prepare Dropbox and provisional bag





Reminders

Daily Closing Tasks

- Log out of pollbooks and produce printer reports
- Unplug hand scanners and unseat from stand
- SUSPEND ballot scanner(s) and TW
- Empty ballot box and place ballots in #3 package
 - Leave ballot box door open
- Empty Dropbox and provisional bag
- Complete all required forms and prepare the courier box for morning pickup
- Complete Reconciliation Log





Reminders

Inside of Courier Box:

- 1.Drop Box Ballots
- 2.Counted Ballots (#3)
- 3.Spoiled Ballots and AB exchanged Ballots
(#4 - enter nos. for each category on label)
- 4.Provisional Ballots
- 5.Voter Registrations
- 6.Gold Forms
- 7.Daily BOD printer oaths (open & close)

Outside of Container:

- 1.EV Courier Chain of Custody Form
