

## **CHANGES**

- Hand scanners on pollbook tablets needs to remain plugged in.
- No more Election Officer buttons. We have lanyards and pins.
- Spoiled Ballots We now TEAR the top left corner of the ballot and put the spoiled ballot and corner in envelope 4.
- The Provisional Ballot Envelope has changed AGAIN.



# **Provisional Ballot Process (Voter)**

- Check reason on Provisional notice and have voter read the notice.
- Give voter a Provisional Ballot Envelope and ballot.
- Send voter to private area to complete envelope, ballot, and then seal ballot in envelope.

# **Provisional Ballot Process (EO)**

- Take sealed envelope from voter.
- Check and sign envelope.
- Complete Tally point log.

## **Provisional Ballot Process**

- Have voter put envelope into Provisional Ballot Bag.
- •Give voter the voter notice and the I voted sticker.



Provisional Voter Notice § 24.2-653, Code of Virginia

Election Officer - Give this notice to all provisional voters

#### Dear voter,

You voted a provisional ballot today.

Your local Electoral Board decides which provisional ballots will be counted. They will meet at 12:00 pm (noon) on the Wednesday after Election Day at 9250 Lee Ave, Suite 1, Manassas, VA 20110.

Your provisional ballot will not be counted if the board cannot confirm that you are qualified and registered to vote in this precinct.

You can provide proof that you are qualified to vote in this precinct in person before the deadline, or you can attend the electoral board meeting to provide proof. (Most people do not need legal counsel, but you may bring a lawyer with you.) If you have questions, call your General Registrar's office at 703-792-6470.

After vote counting is completed, you can find out if your ballot was counted by calling the Department of Elections at 866-839-2556.

- 2. They can come to the Office of Elections in Manassas and vote on the machine.

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# **DE-ESCALATION TECHNIQUES**

## **CLARA**

**Calm** Stay calm, try to put personal feelings aside.

**isten** Avoid interrupting, be concerned, and try to understand the speaker.

## DE-ESCALATION TECHNIQUES (cont.)

Affirm Repeat what you understand to be the issue to show you have heard them. Ask more questions to clarify.

**Respond** Try to brainstorm positions actions that might address their concerns. If that is not possible emphasize the reasons for any restrictions.

Add If appropriate, point out further resources for the voter to check out later.
